I-264 EAST OVERHEAD ELECTRONIC MESSAGE SIGNS AND CAMERAS WILL BE TEMPORARILY OUT OF SERVICE

Maintenance will take approximately one week, beginning January 29

VIRGINIA BEACH —The overhead electronic message signs and closed circuit cameras along I-264 east from Rosemont Road (Exit 18) to Birdneck Road (Exit 22) will be temporarily out of service beginning Sunday, January 29 while repair work is being performed. The work is expected to continue for approximately one week.

Motorists should anticipate delays at southbound Rosemont Road where Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) contractors will make system repairs from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. A portable message sign will be in place on Rosemont Road to alert motorists.
