Question: What is the long-term use/plan to make Three Oaks Elementary Multi-Use Path project an asset, not a liability?

Department: Parks and Recreation CIP

Response: The Three Oaks Elementary Multi-Use Path Project (slide 10 in P&R presentation) will connect the Sherwood Lakes and Highgate Greens neighborhoods to Three Oaks Elementary School. This new asset will provide a safer connection to the school. Currently, there are worn dirt tracks and a makeshift timber board crossing to traverse a small ditch. The project is scheduled to be complete in the summer of 2023. In addition, Three Oaks Park (one of 40 undeveloped park sites) is expected to be developed, and the trail will also serve as a major connector within the park.
