Question: What is the list of regulatory projects in the Southern Watershed?

Department: Public Works

Response: The City reports annually to DEQ a list of potential projects. The City's MS4 Permit Annual reports are on the City's website at www.vbgov.com/stormwater-program.

Potential projects are added to the list when the location has been evaluated to determine that it may be able to accommodate a water quality improvement project. The following projects from the list, as well as more recently identified projects, are in the Southern Rivers Watershed:

1. New City Hall – Manufactured Treatment Device – Under Construction - \$25,000
2. Ashville Park Pond – Wet Pond – Design Ongoing – \$2,510,000
3. Indian River Rd at Lynnhaven Pkwy – Bioretention – Design Ongoing – \$200,000
4. Red Mill Elementary School – Manufactured Treatment Device – Potential Project - \$250,000
5. Virginia Technical Center – Dry Swale & Bioretention – Potential Project – \$840,000
6. Ocean Lakes High School – Dry Swale & Wet Pond – Potential Project – \$1,100,000
7. Ocean Lakes Elementary School – Dry Swale & Bioretention – Potential Project – \$540,000
8. General Booth Blvd – Manufactured Treatment Device – Potential Project – \$570,000
9. Fishers Arch – Constructed Wetland – Potential Project - \$1,750,000
10. Salem Village Park - Manufactured Treatment Device – Potential Project - \$170,000
11. Glenwood Elementary School – Bioretention – Planned Project - \$120,000
12. Salem Rd at Ferrell Pkwy – Wet Pond and Bioretention – Planned Project - \$560,000
13. Brigadoon Lake #5 – Wet Pond Retrofit – Planned Project - \$400,000
