The goals of the 5/31 Memorial Committee shall include:

- creating firm protocols for meeting structure and consensus-building
- creating a vision for the memorial
- setting project priorities, goals, and building consensus on the design
- leading a transparent process open to any interested members of the public or stakeholders
- advocating for the families, survivors, and community
- soliciting input from the stakeholders and public
- developing design goals and recommendations on the memorial site and funding for the memorial using collected input
- determining a preferred location for the memorial
- providing project budgets and mobilizing funding
- soliciting design proposals
- reviewing proposals, conducting selection process, and making a final recommendation to City Council
- overseeing the installation and dedication of memorial

Estimated Time Requirement:

It is anticipated that the Memorial Committee will have multi-day meetings in approximately early to mid-December 2021, mid-January 2022, mid-March 2022 and early May 2022. Meetings will be in-person and a virtual option may be available based on COVID restrictions.
