PAVEMENT CONDITION SURVEY PROJECT BEGINS

Public Works recently began conducting a pavement condition survey and roadway asset collection. The data collected through this program will be used to plan and manage roadway maintenance and repair projects. Public Works is contracting with Roadway Asset Services (RAS) to drive the City-maintained roads with its Roadway Asset Collection (RAC) vehicle to collect video and GPS data on the various roadways.

This process of collection will not require traffic control devices or closures and the RAC vehicle will operate within the flow of traffic during the daylight hours. The program is expected to be completed by the end of December 2022.



GREAT NECK LIBRARY TO CLOSE FOR RENOVATIONS

Virginia Beach Public Library's Great Neck branch will close for renovations beginning tomorrow, Aug. 27, at 5 p.m. Customers who have items on hold may pick them up at the Great Neck Area Library front door Aug. 29 to Sept. 3 and at the Great Neck EMS Station, 1243 Bayne Drive (next door to the library), beginning Sept. 6. During the closure, customers may visit any other VBPL branch for in-person services and programs and also download items from VBPL's [digital library](#).

RIDESHARE ZONE DESIGNATED AT OCEANFRONT THIS WEEKEND

As part of the transportation planning for this weekend’s East Coast Surfing Championship at the Oceanfront, a designated RideShare pick-up and drop-off zone will be provided on Atlantic Avenue northbound, between 9th Street and 12th Street. Until Sunday, Aug. 28, traffic on Atlantic Avenue will have limited access between 2nd Street and 5th Street and between 5th Street and 9th Street due to the event. All RideShare drivers are encouraged to utilize the designated pick-up and drop-off zones.

CITY ASSISTS WITH FULL SCALE MASS CASUALTY EXERCISE


