Meters located on 31st, 15th, 10th
and 6th Street

How to Use the Pay Stations:

- 1. Use any button on key pad to begin**
- 2. Press "1" for initial payment**
- 3. Enter your space number and press "#"**
- 4. Insert coins to add time or insert card, follow on screen instruction** (Press blue button to add time).
- 5. Press green button to complete transaction.**
- 6. Retain receipt for proof of payment** (also has extended time code if you want to add time later)
- 7. Download Parkmobile app**
Add time using a mobile device.






CURFEW FOR MINORS

PET LOVERS

Before Memorial Day and after Labor Day weekend, pets are invited to enjoy the public beaches and Boardwalk area anytime.

However, during the summer months (Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend), they are limited to frolic on the north end of Virginia Beach above 42nd Street and the south end of Virginia Beach in the Sandbridge area **before 10 a.m. and after 6 p.m.** Pets on a leash are allowed on the Boardwalk **only** from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. during the summer months.

In the area from the northern boundary of Little Island Park to the southern boundary of the designated lifeguard-patrolled swimming area located at the terminus of Sandbridge Road.	NO surfing between the hours of: 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. weekdays; 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. weekends & holidays	Not including designated surf areas

Virginia Beach Lifesaving Service operates 50 stations from 1st Street to 89th Street and Croatan Beach, along the Oceanfront.






BIKE RIGHT

FISHING INFORMATION

Cast your line during allowed days and times. Fishing from the shore is prohibited from Rudee Inlet to 42nd Street on weekdays (10 a.m. – 4 p.m.) and on weekends and holidays (10 a.m. – 5 p.m.).




DRINK/PARK RESPONSIBLY

If you know you're in no shape to drive home after an evening out and you parked in one of the Municipal Parking Lots located at 2nd, 4th, 19th, 25th streets or Rudee Loop, get a **"Do Not Tow" sticker** from the lot attendant that will allow you to leave your car overnight. If there is no attendant, contact a police officer or call 757- 385-5600.


Put the "Do Not Tow" sticker on your windshield, and grab a ride from a cab or a friend. You may pick up your vehicle between 8 a.m. and noon the next day.

Municipal parking lots close at 12:30 a.m. to new entries. You must get your sticker prior to 2:30 a.m.



RIP CURRENT SAFETY

Use these helpful tips to “Break the Grip of the Rip!”



IF CAUGHT IN A RIP CURRENT:

- Don't fight the current.
- Swim parallel to the shore, then back to the beach.
- If you can't escape, float or tread water.
- If you need help, call or wave for assistance.

SAFETY:

- Know how to swim.
- Never swim alone.
- If in doubt, don't go out.

BEACH SPORTS

Courtesy volleyball nets are available on a first-come, first-serve basis at 25th, 30th & 40th streets.

Between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on weekends and holidays, playing frisbee and other sports on the beach are prohibited in between Rudee Inlet and 42nd Street, unless otherwise noted.





DO'S & DON'TS

A few do's and don'ts that will ensure you have a great time while in at the Virginia Beach Oceanfront.

- **DO** remember to remove valuables from vehicles.
- **DON'T** have open containers or alcoholic beverages in public areas or in a vehicle.
- **DO** remember to lock your vehicle and hotel room.
- **DON'T** leave personal items unattended.
- **DO** pick up after your pets.
- **DON'T** have pets off-leash or on the beach.
- **DO** ride bikes and surreys on the bike path.
- **DON'T** use electric or motorized vehicles on the boardwalk or beach.
- **DO** pay attention to your surroundings.
- **DON'T** go swimming, rafting or snorkeling more than 50 yards off-shore.
- **Do** have a great time in Virginia Beach.
