



# Proclamation

- WHEREAS:** recognition of the inherent dignity and equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice, and peace in the world;
- WHEREAS:** the General Assembly of the United Nations, on December 10, 1948, declared a Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and has since declared the week of December 10 through 16, of each year, as International Human Rights Week, and December 10 as Human Rights Day, encouraging all individuals and every organ of society to educate and promote respect for human rights through effective recognition and observance of these dates; and,
- WHEREAS:** the Virginia Beach Human Rights Commission is encouraging City-wide recognition and observance of **Human Rights Week** and **Human Rights Day** by sponsoring a Forum on December 15, 1993.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Meyera E. Oberndorf, Mayor of the City of Virginia Beach, Virginia, do hereby **PROCLAIM:**

**VIRGINIA BEACH HUMAN RIGHTS WEEK**


**AND**
