HRSD is constructing a 5.2 million gallon offline storage tank in Woodstock Park under a new state-of-the-art skate facility. Virginia Beach Parks & Recreation has partnered with HRSD to complete improvements to the park including new pavilions, playground equipment, a family restroom, and improved parking.

Dog park: Providence Park, 952 Reon Drive

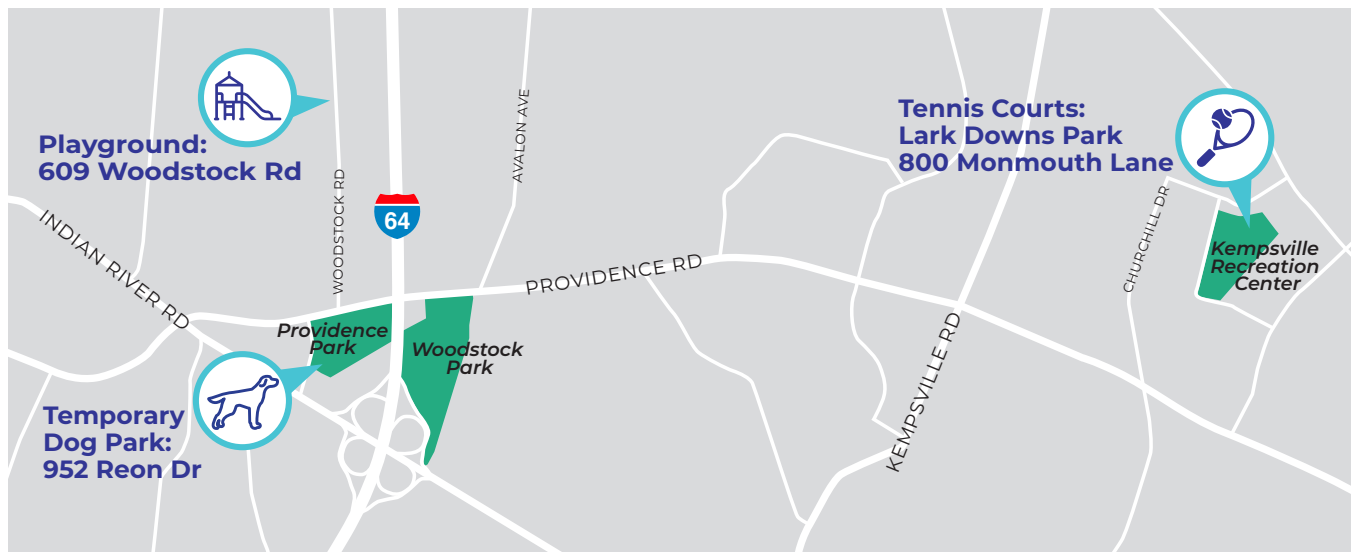
Playground: Woodstock Cove Park, 609 Woodstock Road

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You can expect increased traffic from construction vehicles entering and exiting the site on Providence Road immediately adjacent to I-64.
- In addition, construction outside the park along Barco Drive will take place as early as fall 2019. Comprehensive traffic control plans will minimize inconvenience.
- You can also expect to hear construction noise during normal work hours. City noise ordinances will be followed to dampen excessive noise.
- Planned hours of construction are M-F from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., dependent on weather conditions. Any weekend work will occur after 8 a.m.*
