

Earth Day 2018 Collection Event

Household Hazardous Waste Disposal and Metals Recycling

April 21 (rain date April 22) | Recycling Zone Hours: 10 am - 3 pm

Metals:

- **Metals:** aluminum, stainless steel, metal bed frames, ferrous metal, metal lawn furniture, grills, metal yard ornaments, metal fencing, radiators
- **Electrical Appliances - Examples:** vacuum cleaners, blenders, washers, dryers, ovens, air conditioners, fans, any other motorized appliances
- **Electrical or Gasoline Powered Tools:** lawn mowers, sweepers, trimmers, spreaders, drills, saws, etc.
- **Other:** electrical cords, metal tubing, copper, and brass

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW):

The following items may be dropped off by private citizens but not by businesses:

- Aerosol spray cans
- Appliances containing refrigerant
- Automotive fluids
- Batteries: Alkaline (AA, AAA, C, & D), boat, car, camera, cell phone, hearing aid, lithium, and rechargeable
- Fertilizer, Herbicides, Pesticides
- Household cleaners
- Light Bulbs – all types (CFL and fluorescent included)
- Oil based and latex (water based) paints
- Pool chemicals

No more than 5 gallons of liquids or 75 pounds of dry chemical can be accepted at this event. Waste should be in original container with labeling intact.
