Topic: Construction General Permit Maintenance Fees

In 2014, City Code pertaining to Stormwater Management requirements was amended and included provisions for collection of annual Permit Maintenance fees per [City Code, Appendix D, Sec. 1-33. Fees](#). These fees only apply to projects that have a Virginia Construction General Permit (CGP).

Effective January 1, 2018, the Development Services Center Surety/Permits Technicians will begin emailing and/or mailing invoices to Permit Holders in conjunction with the surety reminder notices.

If the project is complete, the Permit Holder will be given sixty (60) days to terminate the permit in lieu of paying the fee. The request to terminate must be submitted to the DSC office for processing through Virginia's e-permitting system and to initiate final city site inspections. In addition to passing final inspections, Stormwater As-Builts must be approved, the Stormwater Maintenance Agreement recorded and other outstanding items satisfied prior to termination of the permit. If these items cannot be completed within 60 days, the fee will be assessed.
