Topic: Public Works Design Standards Manual Transition Guidelines and Master Drainage Study Information Requests

Effective: Immediately

On June 16, 2020, City Council adopted the Public Works Design Standards Manual (PWDSM) and associated codes and ordinances. Detailed information related to those documents and Transitions Provisions was provided in PCD Notice #2020-06-30 ([link](#)). Effective today, the transition period for site plan submittal has passed, and all newly submitted projects must incorporate designs based on the PWDSM. The June 2020 version of the PWDSM and associated documents have been posted on Public Works' webpage ([link](#)).

Public Works Stormwater Engineering Center staff is currently updating all Master Drainage Study models to incorporate the PWDSM design criteria and expect to have those completed no later than July 24, 2020. If you have already requested a submodel or starting tailwater elevations from the updated master drainage study for use on a project, we expect that information to be provided no later than July 31, 2020.
