Topic: Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Requirements for Developer Installed Sanitary Sewer

Purpose

By requiring that sanitary sewer lateral CCTV inspection is performed during specified points throughout the Public Utilities acceptance process, the city can ensure that it is receiving infrastructure into its inventory that meets construction standards and is damage free. Under the current process, there is an inspection gap that focuses on the sanitary sewer main, but fails to detect lateral service defects that may cause infiltration, blockage, or sanitary sewer overflows. Sanitary sewer lateral defects are one of the largest contributors to the inflow and infiltration (I&I) of storm water and ground water into the sanitary sewer system. Reducing I&I is a requirement under the Regional Consent Order.

Policy

CCTV inspections shall occur at two or three points during the Public Utilities acceptance process to ensure proper installation and that no damage has occurred during construction. The contractor or developer shall contact Public Utilities Inspections at 385-4175 to perform a CCTV inspection on all new and/or replacement sanitary sewer laterals that will be dedicated to the Department of Public Utilities. CCTV inspections shall be completed by a Public Utilities Inspector during the Final Inspection, prior to the Surety Defect Warranty Release (if applicable), and/or prior to Occupancy Release.
