Topic: North Beach Residential Driveway Apron Detail

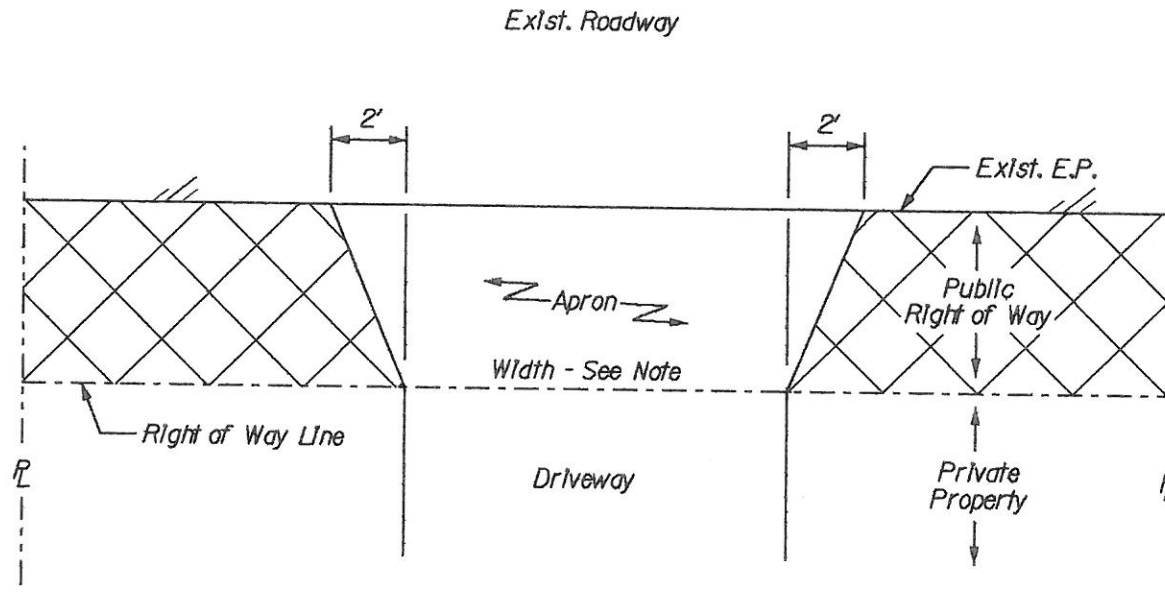
The attached detail “North Beach Streets Residential Driveway Apron Detail” is for residential aprons at the north end. This is **not** a new requirement, just a clarification to the recent inquires and confusion over what is allowed in the right-of-way. The detail shows that no obstructions are allowed in the right-of-way, adjacent to the residential apron. This is to facilitate on-street parking. The detail also indicates that this area adjacent to the apron, in the right-of-way, can consist of grass only.

Effective Date: Has always been a requirement.

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Notes:

1. Width of apron dictated by the North Beach Policy.
2. Area adjacent to apron, in the right of way, shall be free of obstructions including fencing, landscaping, etc.



Area to be topsoil and seeded, gravel or pavement is not allowed.
