

## **Dr. Tal Ezer**

**Professor of Ocean, Earth and Atmospheric Sciences  
Old Dominion University (ODU)**

- Dr. Ezer spent almost 18 years at Princeton University, developing computer ocean circulation models.
- He moved to Norfolk about 11 years ago to focus his research on issues that are important to the Hampton Roads region – the impact of climate change, sea level rise and hurricanes on coastal flooding.
- At ODU he teaches classes on waves and tides and on ocean modeling and prediction.
- Dr. Ezer earned a Ph.D in Physical Oceanography from Florida State University in 1989, a MS in Atmospheric Sciences from Hebrew University of Jerusalem in 1984 and a BS in Physics with a minor in Mathematics from Hebrew University of Jerusalem in 1981
