- Robbie Fearn serves as Center Director of the Donal C. O'Brien, Jr. Sanctuary and Audubon Center in Corolla, NC. As Center Director, Fearn oversees conservation planning impacting the greater Currituck Sound region, construction and renovation of the 2,600 acre property for programming and research activities and engages the local community in the protection of this pristine property. After earning his M.S. in Environmental Studies from Antioch New England Graduate School, Fearn served in many leadership roles including Executive Director of Birmingham's Ruffner Mountain Nature Preserve, Director of the Cape Wildlife Center in Massachusetts, and Education Curator at the Roger Williams Park Zoo in Providence RI. With Millie Overman and a core of dedicated volunteers, he and his wife Pamela cofounded the Network for Endangered Sea Turtles on the Outer Banks. Environmental work is his second career following a 15 year stint in the professional theater as an Equity Production Stage Manager, Director and Designer. He served in many positions at The Lost Colony outdoor drama in Manteo.
