Meetings Enhance Communications

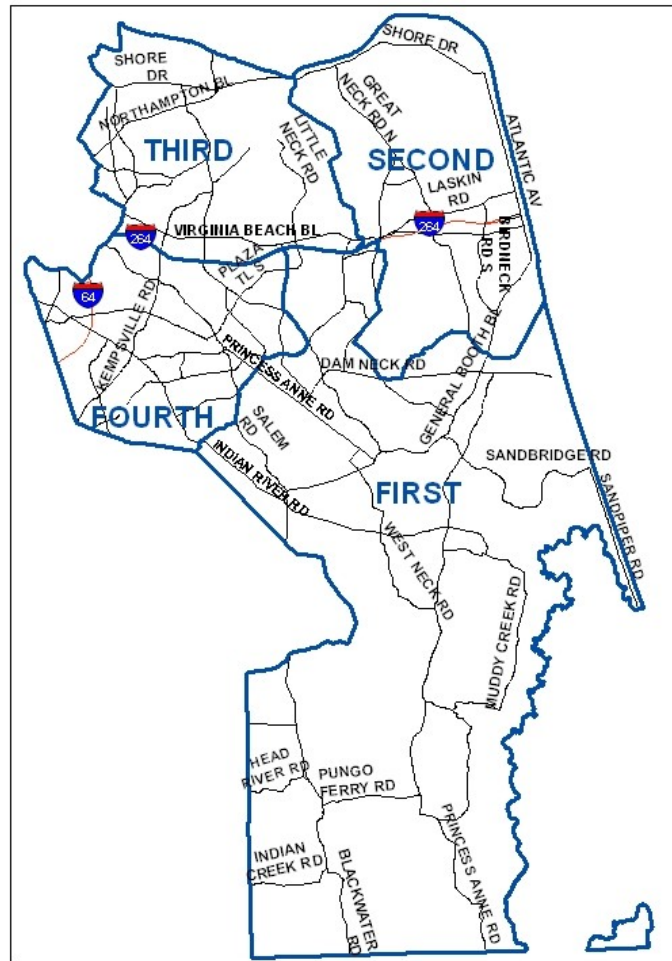
The Virginia Beach Police Department (VBPD) established a program to enhance its ability to communicate with and better serve its community.

The Virginia Beach Citizens' Advisory Committees (CAC) are a collaborative partnership between the VBPD and the citizens who reside within the boundaries of Virginia Beach.

Monthly meetings are open to all Virginia Beach residents. They are held with VBPD commanders and representatives from other city and state agencies. Guest speakers oftentimes provide interesting presentations on various topics.

During meeting, citizens share concerns and discuss combined strategies in which to improve their communities. Meetings also provide a formalized process that facilitates citizen and community cooperation with police.

The CAC is a direct way for the City of Virginia Beach to be more accountable and responsive to citizens and taxpayers.
