

PURPOSE

GOALS

The Virginia Beach TRIAD consists of the Sheriff, the Chief of Police, an AARP representative, as well as senior and retired volunteers who have made a commitment to work together to reduce criminal victimization of senior citizens.

S.A.L.T. is a non-profit, volunteer, non-salaried, working organization dedicated to the protection and well being of the senior population residing in or visiting the City of Virginia Beach.

The primary goal of *VIRGINIA BEACH S.A.L.T.* is to create a sense of security among Virginia Beach seniors by reducing criminal victimization of and enhancing delivery of law enforcement services to seniors.



The mission of S.A.L.T. is to implement activities and programs designed to reduce the level of criminal victimization as it impacts our senior population in Virginia Beach. Efforts in pursuit of this mission are carried out by organized groups who routinely deal with seniors. These groups are made up of multiple agencies that use their combined resources and efforts to accomplish their goals.

The focus of S.A.L.T. is to develop, expand, and implement effective crime prevention and education programs for seniors. These programs target both pre-victimization (prevention) and post-victimization (victim/witness assistance) aspects.

Important to this TRIAD is the council and its' executive board who serve as an information channel, sounding board, and catalyst for renewing emphasis on reducing crime against the elderly together.

Educational, training and instructional counseling groups are organized through volunteers to perform specific tasks, which reduce the vulnerabilities of seniors to those unscrupulous villains who prey upon them.

S.A.L.T. works to improve the quality of life, in all of its elements, for seniors.

The Virginia Beach TRIAD Council, known as S.A.L.T. (*Seniors And Law Enforcement Together*), meets monthly in support of the TRIAD.

S.A.L.T also serves as a liaison for seniors developing close coordination and cooperation with law enforcement.

S.A.L.T. focuses on reducing unwarranted fear of crime on behalf of seniors by providing an opportunity for communication and exchange of information between law enforcement and the senior population of Virginia Beach.
