NOTICE

TO: City of Virginia Beach Residents

SUBJECT: Point O Woods Pump Station No. 259 Replacement (CIP 6-153.000)

The existing sanitary sewer pump station located at 530 W. Plantation Drive has reached the end of its useful life and requires replacement. Construction of a new pump station is planned to begin in early 2021 and will take approximately 15 months to complete. The construction schedule could be impacted by weather or other unforeseen issues. This project is necessary to fix defects in the public infrastructure and to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations.

This project includes demolition of the existing pump station at 530 W. Plantation Drive, installation of a new pump station at 600 N. Great Neck Road, replacement of the sanitary sewer gravity mains in W. Plantation Drive between the existing pump station and new pump station, and pavement replacement where the new sanitary sewer gravity mains will be installed. The new pump station is being relocated to improve access to the site and facilitate easier maintenance. Please refer to the map on the reverse side for project limits.

In order to safely conduct work, W. Plantation Drive will be closed to thru traffic while the new sanitary sewer gravity mains are being constructed. It is anticipated this construction will occur after the new pump station is constructed and will take approximately two months to complete. Residents will have access to their property at all times.

During construction, the Contractor will be staging material and equipment in the City right-of-way. There will be noise, traffic disruptions, and dust during construction. Please understand that every effort will be made to minimize any inconvenience. Areas impacted by construction will be restored back to their original pre-construction condition by project completion.
