TO: City of Virginia Beach Residents

SUBJECT: Project Update - SA 420 New Colony Sanitary Sewer Replacement (CIP 6-111)

Since last year's virtual community information meeting, Virginia Beach Public Utilities has been working thoroughly to prepare for the sanitary sewer replacement project in your neighborhood (see attached map). The project easements have been identified and we plan to contact the impacted properties by the end of March.

Project Description

Starting next winter, Virginia Beach Public Utilities will begin work in the backyard area between New Colony Drive and Old Providence Road to upgrade the sanitary sewer system. This project is anticipated to last 12 months.

Construction during this project will include the replacement of 1,250 feet of gravity sewer lines, 4 manholes, and 65 service connection lines. Residents within the project area should expect the following impacts:

- Construction within the Utility Easements and Temporary Construction Easements.
- Existing fences that encroach within the limits of construction will be removed. Temporary safety fences will be installed at the limits of construction for the duration of the project. Upon completion of the project, new fencing will be constructed along the Utility easement.
- Trees and vegetation within the easements will be removed and the site will be restored.
- Sheds will be relocated outside of the easement limits for the project duration.
