PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

SUBJECT: Project Update – SA 420 New Colony Sanitary Sewer Replacement

Since last year's virtual public meeting, Virginia Beach Public Utilities has been working thoroughly to prepare for the sanitary sewer replacement project in your neighborhood (see attached map). The department plans to begin construction in Spring 2023.

Virginia Beach Public Utilities will hold a public meeting to discuss the updated project schedule and impacts to residents, and to address any questions or concerns.

Location: Kempsville Recreation Center; Kempsville Room

Date/Time: August 30th, 6:30 P.M.

Project Description

Next Spring, Virginia Beach Public Utilities will begin to upgrade the sanitary sewer system in the backyard area between New Colony Drive and Old Providence Road. This is anticipated to last 12 months. Construction during this project will include the replacement of 1,250 feet of gravity sewer lines, 4 manholes, and 65 service connection lines. Residents within the project area should expect the following impacts:

- Construction within the utility easements and temporary construction easements. Removal of existing fences that encroach within the limits of construction. Temporary safety fences will be installed at the limits of construction for the duration of the project. Upon completion of the project, new fencing will be constructed along the Utility easement.
- Fixtures, trees, and vegetation within the permanent utility easements will be removed.
- Sheds will be relocated outside of the easement for the project duration.
