

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Next winter, Virginia Beach Public Utilities will begin work along New Colony Drive and Old Providence Road to upgrade the sanitary sewer system. This project is anticipated to last 12 months.

Construction during this project will include the replacement of 1,250 feet of gravity sewer lines, 4 manholes, 2 sewer cleanouts, and 65 service connection lines.

Residents within the project area should expect the following impacts:

- Fences will be removed for the project duration. A new fence will be installed at the end of the project.
- Trees and vegetation within the easements will be removed.
- Sheds will be relocated outside of the easement limits.

Virginia Beach Public Utilities will hold a virtual public information meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, to discuss the project schedule and impacts to residents, and to address any concerns or questions.
