- I. In order to be included on the City of Virginia Beach Department of Public Utilities courtesy list of Certified Backflow Testers you must provide the required documentation, review the Annual Backflow Prevention Testers Presentation and correctly answer the presentation questions below.
 - A. Required paperwork includes Current Business License, valid certification(s) from a Virginia DPOR Virginia Board for Contractors Approved Backflow Prevention Device Worker School and proof of current test kit calibration(s).
