

**DON'T FORGET YOUR
PHOTO ID WHEN YOU
GO TO VOTE.**



**Virginia law now requires all voters to show
acceptable photo ID at the polls.**

VIRGINIA LAW NOW REQUIRES YOU TO PRESENT AN ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID AT THE POLLS.

1. What's an acceptable photo ID?

Acceptable forms of photo ID include Virginia DMV-issued photo IDs and driver's licenses; U.S. Passports; employer-issued photo IDs; student photo IDs from a college or university located in Virginia; photo ID cards issued by the United States, the Commonwealth of Virginia, or local Virginia government; and Virginia-issued voter photo ID cards.

2. What if I don't have an acceptable photo ID?

You can get a voter photo ID card from any voter registration office for free, including on Election Day. If you show up to vote on Election Day and don't have a photo ID, don't worry! You can still vote a provisional ballot. You must provide a copy of an acceptable photo ID or go get a temporary voter photo ID at your voter registration office by noon on the Friday after the election for your vote to count.
