## Recognition Award

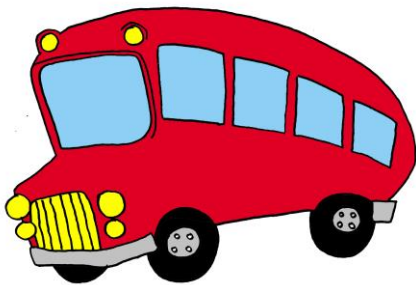
The Bayfront Advisory Commission took time at their meeting on February 19<sup>th</sup> to honor Dan Brockwell, a founding member who sadly, is no longer with us. Commission Chairman Kal Kassir presented a plaque to Ross Brockwell, Dan's eldest son.



Dan was appointed by City Council when it created the Commission, then known as the Shore Drive Advisory Committee, in the late nineteen nineties. He served for nine years and resigned coincidentally with his retirement from the architectural firm he founded in Virginia Beach.

As a planner and resident of the Bayfront community, his contributions were extremely valuable in improving the quality of life for all citizens of the city, and especially those who live, work, visit or play near the Chesapeake Bay.

He will long be remembered for his many contributions. The Commission members will be always grateful for his service and the spirit of volunteerism he instilled in them. Commission meetings are rather quiet without him.



At its meeting on February 19, 2015 The Bayfront Advisory Commission unanimously approved a recommendation to City Council to extend the HRT's trolley service from the Oceanfront to the Bayfront in spring and summer months. The Commissioners believe that such service would allow our visitors to explore the many wonderful amenities such as restaurants, parks and water activities that exist in this thriving section of our city without the hassle of traffic and parking. Conversely it will entice many residents and visitors of the Bayfront to enjoy the boardwalk, fireworks, concerts and so many activities that they currently avoid because of parking and where alcohol is served.

Mayor Sessom directed staff to explore the recommendations with representative of the Commission in the coming weeks. Stay tuned.
