

Access OUT: Exit Atlantic Ave from 9th Street

Avoid Traffic, Take the VB Wave Trolley

- Useful for festival-goers travelling between the Virginia Beach Convention Center, Oceanfront Resorts and Restaurants, and the SOMETHING IN THE WATER Beach Stage venue.

- The trolley shuttle will arrive at the Convention Center every 15 minutes (*subject to traffic*) between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. and drop off at various stops on Atlantic Avenue. WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND you download the **GoHRT Mobile app** to pay with

your phone.

Fare payment can also be made with cash on-board (EXACT CHANGE ONLY) or conventional fare tickets purchased.
